Dear Parents and Carers,

Lisburne School will **remain open**, with a skeleton staff, to support the parents/ carers who are Covid-19 key workers during the Easter holiday. The **government has asked parents to keep their children at home, wherever possible**, and asked schools to remain open only for those children who absolutely need to attend.

After the Easter break we will continue to support all our parents and carers who are Covid-19 critical key workers. In addition to this we will be contacting families of our most vulnerable children, those who have a social care team working on their behalf, to see how we can support these individuals. During this very difficult time we will be looking at enabling our most vulnerable children to come in to school on a week by week rota between 10-2pm. We would like to stress that **school will no longer be a place of education but only provides emergency child-care** and we must therefore ensure places are based on need. Please be aware that to protect everyone involved, **no children will be allowed in to school with underlying health conditions or symptoms of the virus**. Please ensure that families screen children before they come in to school;

A temperature of 37.8C or above

A new or persistent cough

Any member of the family currently self-isolating with Coronavirus symptoms

If a child has any of these then they must self-isolate and **MUST NOT** come in to school.

We are continuing to review and update our arrangements following Government announcements about the spread of COVID-19. Please be aware that information may change at short notice.

We hope that everyone stays safe and well. We want to express our gratitude to all our families for your continued support during this exceptionally difficult time. We will continue to keep in touch through our school website, Dojo and Tapestry - please keep checking these for regular updates.
