

# Autumn term 2020

## Beech Class

### English

**Sensory stories:** We will be looking at several sensory stories such as Granny went to Market & Handa's Surprise

This half term we will be using the book 'Here we are' along with our sensory stories to help influence our writing, mark making and reading targets. We will also be working on our individual speaking and listening targets.

### Maths

**Number:** We will be using Numicon to help us count, compare and complete calculations. We will also be incorporating fine motor activities with pom-poms and threading activities.

**Measure:** This term we will be exploring comparative language such as big/ small, heavy/light and long/short.

**Geometry:** We will be focusing on using shape to create patterns and using prepositional language to describe where an object is.

### Topic

**Where in the world are we going:  
What cultures are around the world?**

During our topic this term, we will be exploring different cultures around the world through food. We will be exploring different cultures within different countries, such as Mexico, Pakistan and The UK. We will explore the different cultures within Beech class and talk about our own family trees.

**PSHE:** Social and Interaction, In the community we all have road safety targets and we have individual self-care targets.
