English

Sensory stories: Here We Are. This half term we will be using our sensory stories to help influence our writing, mark making and reading targets. We will be using drama and engagement techniques to immerse ourselves within the story. We will also be working on our individual speaking and listening targets.

Topic

Our World

During our topic this term, we will be exploring different animals from around the world and the habitats they live in. We will be listening to animal sounds, watching videos and recreating their habitats. We will learn about the weather in different continents that wild animals live in, the type of food the animals eat and what the animals like to do.

Maths

Number: We will be using Numicon to help us count, compare and complete calculations. We will also be incorporating fine motor activities with pom-poms, Cheerio's and pipe cleaners to help with our number skills.

Measure: This term we will be exploring comparative language such as big/ small, thick/ thin, before/ after.

Geometry: We will be focusing on creating different patterns in the environment and prepositional language.
