- Measure: Money

Our whole school maths focus this year is measure. Measure extends beyond our classroom and is included throughout forest school, cookery and life skills sessions. Each week we encourage the children to explore maths through an exploratory play station set up in the classroom!

Topic

'People Past and Present'

This term we will be exploring different people's cultures and traditions from around the world. We will be looking at people from the past and the present including; ourselves, the Romans, the Egyptians and different African tribes. Throughout the topic we will be exploring how clothing, housing and lifestyles differ. In Hazel we will do this through;

- Sensory exploration
- Dress up, drama and role-play.
- Arts and Crafts.
- Food tasting.
- Music therapy & Dance.

Science: States of matter



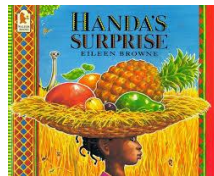
