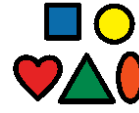
Autumn Term 2020



English



- We will be reading and comparing stories from other cultures.
- Next we will be reading, writing and performing our own Autumn poems.
- Through the use of non-fiction texts, we will be learning about different inventions.
- Finally, we will be reading stories that raise issues.



Maths



- We will be looking at numbers and the number system, comparing and ordering numbers.
- In measure, we will be looking at capacity, using different measuring equipment.
- There will also be a focus on money – recognising coins, adding and subtracting amounts of money and giving change.
- In Geometry, we will look at 2D and 3D shapes, position and direction.



Other subject areas



Science – Our science topic is “States of Matter”. We will be exploring different materials and observing the changes that occur when they are mixed or exposed to different temperatures. We will develop our knowledge and understanding of the terms solid, liquid and gas, predict and fair test.

Topic - Our topic focus “Our World of Tomorrow”. We will be looking at the role of inventors in changing our world and how famous inventions have made our lives much easier. We will research famous inventors to find out when and where they lived and what they invented. We will be trying out some of our own inventions!

PSHE – This term, our focus is on “Friendships and Family”. We will be discussing the question, “What makes a good friend?” and thinking about our families and the people who are special to us.
