TRANSITION THROUGH SCHOOLS

ENTERING LISBURNE, WE WILL:



- Liaise with the current educational setting.
- Visit the family at home to offer/gain information.
- Organise visits to Lisburne to aid the transition process.
- Ensure each child has a transition booklet prior to starting at School.
- Pass on all health, educational and personal information to the class teacher/teams and other professionals as required.

LEAVING LISBURNE, WE WILL:

- Work Closely with the class teacher/team and family to aid a smooth transition period.
- Accompany parents/carers with Year 5 secondary school visits as requested.
- Attend the year 5 transition review
- Assist Year 6 transition visits and accompany the child/children if needed.
- Organise transition booklets/information.

- Being proactive in their approach when giving support..
- Providing relevant information.
- Assistance with forms, including DLA, charity applications, support letters etc.

- Support at home and in the community.
- Regular workshops, including Makaton, sleep, feeding, positive solutions.
- Providing information on local services e.g. health, social care
- and voluntary groups and how to access their support.
