Research/ Secondary sources

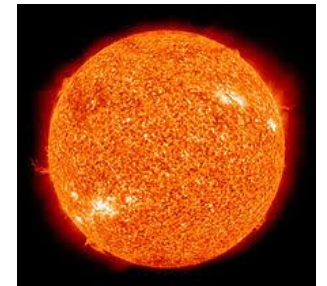
- To research about different light sources including the sun; and present their findings.
