Aims of Policy.	 To make sure/ ensure? that All children and staff are happy and safe. Everyone takes responsibility for their actions. Issues are dealt with positively, fairly and consistently.
Positive behaviour for Learning.	 We will encourage and teach good behaviour. Good behaviour promotes learning.
School Rules	 Stop, think before you act. Keep your hands & feet to yourself. Tell an adult if you are upset. Use kind words.
Rewards and Recognition.	Rewards can vary according to each child. In addition to this, all pupils can access : • Good work or Sharing Assembly. • Happy Book with Sticker. • Headteachers Award. • Star Pupil Award.
Supporting Positive Behaviour.	 Assistance for parents/carers from Karen Wilson (School Family Liaison Assistant). Guide parents/carers to other agencies for support. Maintaining home/school communication

Keeping our School Community Safe.	 Safeguarding procedures will be carried out to keep all our pupils safe. All staff are trained to use calming techniques to diffuse unacceptable behaviours.
Consequences.	 These vary according to each child. Parents/carers will be contacted to discuss any concerns when appropriate.
